The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Area Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award non-renewable scholarships in the amounts of \$500-\$1000 for the General Scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded to deserving African American high school female or male seniors who will graduate from area high schools in Orange and Chatham counties this 2020-2021 school year. Recipients must attend an accredited college or university in the fall of 2021. Selection of recipients is based on the following criteria:

#### 1. Students applying for the General Scholarship (\$500-\$1000) requirements:

- 1. An official sealed transcript showing required cumulative grade point average of at least a **2.5 or** above and a combined SAT score of **900** or above or an **ACT** composite of **20** or above.
- 2. Two (2) recommendations one from a **Teacher** and one from a **Community Organization**.
- 3. One (1) **typed essay** of 300 words or less which answers the provided question.

The deadline for submitting all information is **Friday**, **April 23**, **2021**. The application and <u>all</u> required information must come in <u>one packet</u>, **ON LINE Submission www.chaac-dst.org** (please no certified mail that requires a signature). Information received after April 23, 2021 will disqualify the applicant.

#### **Application Process**

The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Area Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award scholarships to graduating African American high school female and male seniors. Students who attend the following Orange and Chatham County high schools are eligible to apply:

Carrboro High School East Chapel Hill High School Cedar Ridge High School Jordan Matthews High School Chapel Hill High School Northwood High School Chatham Central High School Orange High School

<u>Criteria</u>: Students who desire to apply for a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- African American female or male student.
- Plan to attend a 2 or 4-year institution of higher learning in the United States in the 2021-2022 school year
- Achieve a minimum high school unweighted GPA of 2.5 (General Scholarship) or 3.5
- Participate in extra-curricular and/or public service activities.
- Participate in the interview process.
- Typed essay(s) on topic provided

Multiple non-renewable scholarships will be awarded in amounts of \$500-\$1,000 (General Scholarship).

#### Application Packet Postmarked By April 23, 2021

The Complete Application Packet must include:

A completed application (typed)

#### Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (typed)

Two letters of recommendation from a classroom teacher and a community service supervisor attesting to character, academic achievement, leadership, and community service.

Letters of recommendation will not be accepted from relatives or members of the scholarship committed. The letters should be sealed and signed across the seal of the envelope by the recommender. They must be included in your application packet.					
Typed Essay (limited to two double spaced pages in 12-point font)					
<ol> <li>General Scholarship Essay Topic -The essay must be attached as indicated to the cover page of you application packet.</li> </ol>					
Academic Transcript Your official high school transcript must be included in your packet. It must be in an envelope that has beer signed by your School Counselor across the sealed back flap of the envelope.					
Interview					

Interviews for final consideration for the scholarship will be held on Saturday, May 1, 2021. Only those selected for final consideration will be interviewed. If you are selected to be interviewed, you will be notified by telephone or email of the interview location and scheduled time during the week of April 26, 2021.

Must bring a Photo ID when interviewed. Interview date May 1, 2021 (ZOOM info. to be provided).
